Terms of the competition

All entrants must comply with the Gender and Fairness in Competition Policy.

Entrants Must:

1. Be a paid-up Member of Myerscough Golf Club.
2. Have an 'active' handicap.
(Active means a minimum of 8 x 18 hole or equivalent 9-hole qualifying scores on their WHS scoring record within the previous 18 months).
3. Have been a member of the club for a minimum of **3 months** in the competition year.
4. If there are outstanding entry fees, competitors will not be eligible to continue in the competition or enter future club competitions.

Club Championship is an 18-hole Stroke play qualifying competition played on a nominated Saturday.

All players are expected to play in the spirit of the game by:

- Acting with integrity – for example, by following the Rules, applying all penalties, and being honest in all aspects of play.
- Showing consideration to others – for example, by playing at a prompt pace, looking out for the safety of others, and not distracting the play of another player.
- Taking good care of the course – for example, by replacing divots, smoothing bunkers, repairing ball-marks, and not causing unnecessary damage to the course.

Applying the Rules

- Player Responsibility for Applying the Rules. Players are responsible for applying the Rules to themselves:

Meaning of “Rules”;

The “Rules” means:

- Rules 1-25 and their Definitions in the Rules of Golf, and
- Any “Local Rules” the Committee adopts for the competition or the course.

It is recommended that players read up on some of the more useful rules such as, but not limited to.

- Abnormal course conditions.
- Embedded Ball.
- Red Penalty areas.
- Ball unplayable.
- Loose impediment.

For anyone with an interest it is also recommended that you download the Rules App.

Local Rules

If any local rules need to be introduced, they will be communicated by email added to the members forum mgmf.co.uk and posted on the Club notice board.

Competition

All entrants must have registered and paid the entrance fee.

The competition will be played on a nominated Saturday.

The Date will be available on mgmf.co.uk and HowDidiDo and a reminder sent to all competitors by email, at the start of the season, prior to the event starting.

Entrants must sign in on Howdidido by the nominated date and enter their scores **on the day of play.**

Entrants will play off 95% of their playing handicap.

There will be a draw for Tee’s done using the Club Software.

On the day of the final the first tee off will be at 09:00. All qualifiers are required to check in with club officials by no later than 20 minutes before their allocated tee time. Players arriving after and no later than 5 minutes past their tee time will incur a 2 shot penalty. If a player arrives after 5 minutes past their tee time they will be disqualified.

Ties will be resolved using the countback system on HowDidiDo.

Cards MUST be placed in the post box on the same day the member signs in and plays the round.

The result will be published via HowDidiDo as soon as possible after the round.

Winners and other prizes will be presented at prize giving during the AGM or an alternative date agreed by the committee.

Cancellations

Myerscough Golf Club reserves the right to postpone the competition. The members will be notified as soon as possible.

Issues or concerns during play

Issues or concerns raised during the competition must be reported to either the handicap secretary or member of the committee as soon as is practicable on the day of the competition.

A player who is uncertain about the right procedure while playing a hole may complete the hole with two balls without penalty:

- The player must decide to play two balls after the uncertain situation arises and before making a stroke.
- The player should choose which ball will count if the Rules allow the procedure used for that ball, by announcing that choice to his or her marker or to another player before making a stroke.
