Terms of the competition

All entrants must comply with the Gender and Fairness in Competition Policy.

Entrants Must:

1. Be a paid-up Member of Myerscough Golf Club.
2. Have an 'active' handicap.
(Active means a minimum of 8 x 18 hole or equivalent 9-hole qualifying scores on their WHS scoring record within the previous 18 months).
3. Have been a member of the club for a minimum of **3 months** in the competition year.
4. If there are outstanding entry fees, competitors will not be eligible to continue in the competition or enter future club competitions.

Monthly medals are 18-hole Stroke play qualifying competitions played over nominated weekends

All players are expected to play in the spirit of the game by:

- Acting with integrity – for example, by following the Rules, applying all penalties, and being honest in all aspects of play.
- Showing consideration to others – for example, by playing at a prompt pace, looking out for the safety of others, and not distracting the play of another player.
- Taking good care of the course – for example, by replacing divots, smoothing bunkers, repairing ball-marks, and not causing unnecessary damage to the course.

Applying the Rules

- Player Responsibility for Applying the Rules. Players are responsible for applying the Rules to themselves:

Meaning of “Rules”;

The “Rules” means:

- Rules 1-25 and their Definitions in the Rules of Golf, and
- Any “Local Rules” the Committee adopts for the competition or the course.

It is recommended that players read up on some of the more useful rules such as, but not limited to.

- Abnormal course conditions.
- Embedded Ball.
- Red Penalty areas.
- Ball unplayable.
- Lose impediment.

For anyone with an interest it is also recommended that you download the Rules App.

Local Rules

If any local rules need to be introduced, they will be communicated by email and posted on the Club notice board

Competition

All entrants must have registered and paid the entrance fee.

The competitions can be played anytime over a fixture weekend. Players will be entitled to sign in and play a round on either, Friday, Saturday, or Sunday.

Dates will be available on mgmf.co.uk and HowDidiDo and a reminder sent to all competitors by email, at the start of the season, prior to the event starting.

Members playing in the competition must play with another club Member.

Entrants must sign in on HowDidiDo and enter their scores onto the system **on the day of play**.

In case of error or system malfunction, it is advised that members complete a card and put it in the box in reception.

Any member who has difficulty with HowDidiDo either on the APP or in reception **MUST** place a card in the box and let Barry Jackson know ASAP after your round.

Entrants will play off 95% of their playing handicap.

There will be 2 Divisions:

Division one for players up to a playing handicap of 18.

Division two for players with a playing handicap above 18.

There will also be a 2's competition.

The winner for each division will be lowest nett scoring player from all competitors in that division.

Ties will be resolved using the countback system on HowDidiDo.

Cards MUST be placed in the post box on the same day the member signs in and plays the round.

The results will be published via HowDidiDo as soon as possible after each round.

Winners and other prizes will be presented at prize giving during the AGM or an alternative date agreed by the committee.

Cancellations

Myerscough Golf Club reserves the right to cancel a competition at any stage of the weekend. In the event of cancellation members will be notified as soon as possible. A competition weekend may get rescheduled. The competition will not be cancelled if the course is closed for a single day. If due to course conditions (and the college is not able to close it) less than 30% of entrants play over a given weekend that round will be cancelled.

Awards

Prizes will be awarded to players placed 1st, 2nd, in each division.

The winner will be announced on the day and acknowledge at the AGM.

Issues or concerns during play

Issues or concerns raised during any competition must be reported to either the handicap secretary or member of the committee as soon as is practicable but at the latest on the Monday after the competition closes.

A player who is uncertain about the right procedure while playing a hole may complete the hole with two balls without penalty:

- The player must decide to play two balls after the uncertain situation arises and before making a stroke.
- The player should choose which ball will count if the Rules allow the procedure used for that ball, by announcing that choice to his or her marker or to another player before making a stroke.
