Terms of the competition

All entrants must comply with the Gender and Fairness in Competition Policy.

Entrants Must:

1. Be a paid-up Member of Myerscough Golf Club.
2. Have an 'active' handicap.
(Active means a minimum of 8 x 18 hole or equivalent 9-hole qualifying scores on their WHS scoring record within the previous 18 months).
3. Have been a member of the club for a minimum of **3 months** in the competition year.
4. If there are outstanding entry fees, competitors will not be eligible to continue in the competition or enter future club competitions.

This is a 9-hole Stableford qualifying competition that will consist of up to 12 qualifying rounds, played over nominated weekends. Followed by a final, for those who qualify, being played over 18 holes.

There will be 2 divisions with the handicap split being dependent on numbers of entrants and their handicap. The split will give, as close as possible, an equal number of members in each division.

All players are expected to play in the spirit of the game by:

- Acting with integrity – for example, by following the Rules, applying all penalties, and being honest in all aspects of play.
- Showing consideration to others – for example, by playing at a prompt pace, looking out for the safety of others, and not distracting the play of another player.
- Taking good care of the course – for example, by replacing divots, smoothing bunkers, repairing ball-marks, and not causing unnecessary damage to the course.

Applying the Rules

- Player Responsibility for Applying the Rules. Players are responsible for applying the Rules to themselves:

Meaning of “Rules”;

The “Rules” means:

- Rules 1-25 and their Definitions in the Rules of Golf, and
- Any “Local Rules” the Committee adopts for the competition or the course.

It is recommended that players read up on some of the more useful rules such as, but not limited to.

- Abnormal course conditions.
- Embedded Ball.
- Red Penalty areas.
- Ball unplayable.
- Loose impediment.

For anyone with an interest it is also recommended that you download the Rules App.

Local Rules

If any local rules need to be introduced, they will be communicated by email added to the members forum mgmf.co.uk and posted on the Club notice board.

Competition

All entrants must have registered and paid the entrance fee.

The qualifying rounds can be played anytime over a fixture weekend. Players will be entitled to sign in and play a round on either, Friday, Saturday, or Sunday.

Dates will be available on mgmf.co.uk and HowDidiDo and a reminder sent to all competitors by email, at the start of the season, prior to the event starting.

Members playing in the competition must play with another club Member.

Entrants must sign in on HowDidiDo and enter their scores onto the system **on the day of play**.

In case of error or system malfunction, it is advised that members complete a card and put it in the box in reception.

Any member who has difficulty with HowDidiDo either on the APP or in reception **MUST** place a card in the box and let Barry Jackson know ASAP after your round.

Entrants will play off 95% of their playing handicap.

The qualifying rounds will be followed by a final play-off competition.

There will also be a 2's competition.

The winner for each round and the final will be highest scoring Stableford scoring player.

Ties will be resolved using the countback system on HowDidiDo.

To ensure fairness and equity across the handicap range there will be 2 Divisions:

Division one for players with a playing handicap up to the mid-point of handicaps of all entrants post round 12.

Division two for players with a playing handicap above the mid-point of handicaps of all entrants post round 12.

Players handicaps post round 12 should be a true reflection of their current ability.

Finalists will be informed as soon as practicable after round 12 with a minimum of 1 weeks' notice (the date of the final is on HowDidiDo , so should not be a surprise).

The final will be played over 18 holes with qualifiers from Div 1 and Div 2 competing equally for the chance to win the final

Note: *in the event of inclement weather on the day of the final the committee reserves the right to reduce the final to a 9-hole competition or as a last resort reschedule the event to the next available Saturday the course is fit to play.*

The results will be published via HowDidiDo as soon as possible after each round.

Winners and other prizes will be presented at prize giving during the AGM or an alternative date agreed by the committee.

Qualifying

- a) Out of all possible qualifying rounds, competitors must submit at least four qualifying cards from the qualification stage. The best four rounds submitted per player count towards qualification to the final.
- b) The top 50% (worked out as 25% per division) with the best four round total scores, including ties will qualify for the final. No substitutes or replacements for anyone not able to make the final.

- c) In the event of fixtures being cancelled, the number of qualifying scores may be reduced or a competition weekend may get rescheduled.
- d) A weekend qualification round will not be cancelled if the course is closed for a single day. If due to course conditions (and the college is not able to close it) less than 30% of entrants play over a given weekend that round will be cancelled.
- e) On the day of the final the first tee off will be at 09:00. All qualifiers are required to check in with club officials by no later than 20 minutes before their allocated tee time. Players arriving after and no later than 5 minutes past their tee time will incur a 2 shot penalty. If a player arrives after 5 minutes past their tee time they will be disqualified.
- f) On the day of the final the player with the highest Stableford score over the number of holes played will be the winner. In the event of a tie, there will be a sudden death playoff using holes 1, 8 and 9.
- g) Any Local or Competition rules will be published prior to the start of each competition round. These local or Competition rules apply for each qualification round and the final if required.
- h) Any issues arising during the Competition are to be raised with a Committee Member as soon as possible and before 16:00 hours on the Sunday of the weekend being played.

Awards

Prizes will be awarded to players placed 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th in the final. All players making the final will be presented with an award to mark their qualification.

The winner of each round will be given an award.

The winner will be announced on the day and acknowledge at the AGM.

Issues or concerns during play

Issues or concerns raised during any competition must be reported to either the handicap secretary or member of the committee as soon as is practicable but at the latest on the Monday after the competition closes.

A player who is uncertain about the right procedure while playing a hole may complete the hole with two balls without penalty:

- The player must decide to play two balls after the uncertain situation arises and before making a stroke.
- The player should choose which ball will count if the Rules allow the procedure used for that ball, by announcing that choice to his or her marker or to another player before making a stroke.
